Passover Story

Reader1:-

Telling of the Passover Story

Pharaoh the King of Egypt, made a law that every boy baby of the Hebrew race should be killed, and there was great sorrow because of it.

But when Moses was born, his mother managed to hide him for three months; then she made a cradle, or little ark, and putting him into it, carried him down to a river and hid the cradle among the reeds there.

Soon after this, Pharaoh's daughter came with her maidens to the river-side, and when she saw the beautiful child, she sent one of her maidens to bring it to her.

She took the little boy to the palace and named him Moses, and he became a great man among the Egyptians; he knew, however, that he belonged to the Hebrew race, and when he saw how badly his own people were being treated he tried to help them; but at last he was obliged to leave Egypt. He became a shepherd, taking care of the flocks of a Priest called Jethro. He also married Jethro's daughter.

After a time, Yahweh God spoke to Moses out of a burning bush, and told him that he must go and rescue his people from the cruel Egyptians. Moses thought he could not do this; but Yahweh promised to help him, and to show him what he would be able to do with His help.

Yahweh turned the rod which Moses carried into a serpent. Then Yahweh told Moses to pick the serpent up by the tail, and as he did so it became a rod again. He showed him another sign also; but Moses was still afraid because he could not talk well and thought that Pharaoh would not listen to him. So Yahweh told him to take his brother Aaron as a spokesman.

Reader2:-

Moses and Aaron, therefore, went into Egypt where they called together the chief men among their own people, the Hebrews, or the Israelites, and told them what Yahweh had commanded. Moses also did the miracle that Yahweh has given him power to do. The people believed that Yah had sent him.

After this Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and told him that it was the Lord Gods command that he should let the Israelites go. Pharaoh knew nothing about Yahweh and became very angry, saying that Moses and Aaron kept the people from their work by telling them such things; and he treated the Israelites worse than before.

But Moses had faith in Yahweh so he was able to perform before the King the wonderful things that he had done before his own people. Pharaoh still would not let the people of Israel go.

Then Moses turned the waters of the rivers to blood; and after that he caused large numbers of frogs to run over the land and the houses, doing great harm. He also brought locusts and other insects to be a pest to the people and caused many of the useful animals which belonged to the Egyptians to get sick and die. He did all these wonders with the rod which Yahweh had given him. But pharaoh would not listen to him.

Then Yahweh commanded Moses again, and he brought other plagues upon the Egyptians; Pharaoh still would not give in. Altogether Yahweh brought ten plagues upon Egypt.

At last however Yahweh sent them still more terrible trouble; for the first born of every Egyptian family, and even the first born among the flocks, died; although the Israelites who had put blood on their door post so the death angel would pass over, were spared, as they had been throughout all the plagues.

Death of the First Born

Then Pharaoh was frightened into obeying Yah, and let the Israelites go; so they started at once for the land of Canaan, and the Lord God guided them during the day by a cloud, and at night by a Pillar of fire.

But Yahweh commanded Moses to stretch forth his rod over the sea; he did so, and the waters parted, making a high wall on either side, so that the children of Israel passed through and reached the other side in safety.
