The Seven Seals of Revelation Ch 6,7 & 8 **& The Seventh Seal Trumpet Judgements**

The first seal-

Rider on a white horse who goes out conquering and to conquer

“I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer”. Rev 6:2

The second seal-

Rider on a red horse, to take peace from the earth, that men would slay one another; and a great sword was given to him

“And another, a red horse, went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, and that men should slay one another, and a great sword was given to him”. **Rev 6:4**

The third seal-

Rider on a black horse who has a pair of scales in his hand

“When He broke the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying, “Come”.

I looked and behold, a black horse; and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand.

And I heard something like a voice in the centre of the four living creatures saying, “A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not damage the oil and the wine”. **Rev 6:5,6**

The fourth seal-

Rider called Death on an ashen horse, has Hades following him to go over a quarter of the earth to kill with sword, famine, pestilence and wild beast

I looked and behold an ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name of Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and with pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth”

Rev 6:8

The fifth seal

The souls of the Martyrs cry out

When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain, because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained;

And they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, Holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until the number of their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also". **Rev 6:9-11**

The sixth seal-

Great terror upon the earth

I looked when He broke the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake;

And the sun became black as sackcloth made of hair, and the whole moon became like blood;

And the stars of the sky fell to the earth, as a fig tree casts its unripe figs when shaken by a great wind.

The sky was split apart like a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the commanders and the rich and the strong and every slave and free man hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains;

And they said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb;

For the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

Rev 6:12-17

The seventh seal

Seven angels sound their trumpets bringing seven judgements

When the Lamb broke the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for half an hour.

And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

And the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound them. **Rev 8:3-6**

Summary of the seven seals

The first seal-

Rider on a white horse who goes out conquering and to conquer

Seventh Seal Seven Trumpet Judgements Summary
(Rev 8:7-9:21)

First trumpet

Hail and fire came mixed with blood and they were thrown to the earth, a third of the earth the trees were burned up and all the grass was burned up.

Rev 8:7

Second trumpet

Something like a great mountain burning was thrown into the sea and a third of the sea became blood

A third of the creatures alive in the sea died and a third of the ships were destroyed. **Rev 8:8,9**

Third trumpet

A great star called Wormwood fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water.

A third of the waters became Wormwood and many men died from the bitter waters. **Rev 8:10**

Fourth trumpet

A third of the sun, and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck and a third of them were darkened. The day would not shine and the night the same way. **Rev 8:12,13**

Fifth trumpet

A star from heaven fell to earth and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him who opened it and smoke went forth out of it like the smoke of a great furnace, the air was darkened by the smoke of the pit. Locusts came out of it with power to harm those who do not have the seal of God on their forehead
They were not to hurt the grass nor any green thing or trees only men who do not have the seal of God on the forehead **Rev 9:1-12**

Sixth trumpet

And I heard a voice from the four horns and the golden altar which is before God

One said to the sixth angel release the four angels bound at the Euphrates.

The four angels prepared for the day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind

The number of the armies of the horsemen was two hundred million. Horses and those who sat on them; the riders had breastplates the colour of fire and of hyacinth and of brimstone; the horses heads are like

the heads of loins; and out of their mouth proceed fire and smoke and brimstone.

A third of mankind was killed by these three plagues, by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which proceed out of their mouths.

The power of the horses is in their mouths and their tails. The tails are like serpents and have heads that do harm.

The rest of mankind who were not killed by the plagues did not repent so as not to worship demons, and idols of gold and silver and brass, stone and wood.

They did not repent of their murders, sorceries, immorality or theft.

Rev 9:13-21

Seventh trumpet

Loud voices in heaven say “The kingdom of this world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of the Christ; and He will reign forever and ever”

Twenty four elders who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God saying “ We give you thanks O Lord, the Almighty, who are and who were, because you have taken Your great power and have begun to reign.

The nations are enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time came for the dead to be judged, and the time to reward Your bond servants the prophets, and the saints, those who fear Your name, the small and great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth.

Temple of God in heaven was opened, the ark of His covenant appeared in His temple, there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder and an earthquake and a great hailstorm.

Rev 11:15-19

John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

Matthew 24:30,31 Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

(v31) And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.
